



## Terms and Conditions

### -- Art. 1 The Event

Vespa World Days 2025 will be held in Gijón-Spain from 1st to 4th May 2025.

### -- Art. 2 Admission

All persons who are registered members of a local Vespa Club affiliated with a National Vespa Club that is a member of the Vespa World Club may register. Only original Vespa and Cosa vehicles, legally authorized and insured, are admitted to this event.

From 1<sup>st</sup> December up to 15th December 2024 the online registration tool will be opened for 2000 people as FULL and 2.500 as LITE, with caps according to nationality to ensure representation from as many countries as possible. The quota initially assigned to each country will be followed.

After the 15th, the Organizing Committee will release unoccupied spots for other participants based on the registration order on the waiting list.

National Vespa Club Presidents must validate the list of Vespa Clubs in their country. Only after this validation will the Organizing Committee send confirmation of inclusion.

At this stage, we will only register participation in the event. All additional services, such as tours (rides out) and other activities, will be made available from 1st up to 15th March. Other exclusive services dedicated only to registered participants may be added and communicated later.

### -- Art. 3 Entry fee

The participation fees are:

- LITE: 90€ (ninety euros), valid for 2.500 Vespisti
- FULL: 130€ (one hundred thirty euros), valid for 2.000 Vespisti

(Both fees are VAT inclusive)

All Vespisti registered with a local Vespa Club recognized by their National Vespa Club of reference may participate.

The entrance ticket includes:

- A – Official program accessible by QR code or APP
- B – Event welcome kit with exclusive items: bag, metal badge, shield banner, patch, sticker, brooch (pin), mug, and neck warmer
- C – Access to Vespa Village and all planned activities inside
- D – Vespa Parking, which will be guarded during Vespa Village opening ours.
- E – Free entrance in 12 Gijón museums
- F – Free participation in the Vespa Parade
- G – Complementary parade box lunch
- H – Eligibility to participate in the Concorso di Eleganza (Elegance Contest)



I – Eligibility to participate in the Concorso di Abbigliamento Storico da Pilota (Vintage Rider's Outfit Contest)

J – Free participation in the Gymkhana.

K – Opportunity to participate in officially organized rides after registration on the event website

L – Free access to the special “Vespiti New Year's Eve” party

Our FULL fee also includes participation in the Saturday Gala Dinner, specially designed to showcase the high-quality regional cuisine provided by the catering service of the prestigious Princesa de Asturias Awards. We aim to make sure no one is left out, allowing everyone to be part of a global Vespa celebration in Spain.

The registration fee is non-refundable; however, participant names can be changed if the replacement is a member of the same Vespa Club. Changes must be submitted via an email from the Vespa Club President before 1st March.-- Art. 4 Other rules

In addition to the rules and guidelines outlined here, those of the Vespa World Club for international Vespa events apply. The organizer disclaims all risks and liabilities toward participants, who bear full responsibility. The organizer is not liable for claims by participants or third parties resulting from actions or omissions by participants. Spanish law applies to all aspects of the event. For health and safety reasons, external food and drinks are not allowed in the Vespa Village.-- Art. 5 Change of event program

The organizer reserves the right to change the program without prior notice.

-- Art. 6 Registration and Organization

Registration opens on 1st December 2024 at 08:00 CET (Madrid, Paris, Rome). Payment must be completed between 1st and 15th January 2025, following the official confirmation of inclusion, which will be verified only on the registration site. For queries, National Vespa Club Presidents may contact [info@vespaworlddays2025spain.es](mailto:info@vespaworlddays2025spain.es). With only 4,500 places available, it is essential to confirm participation before proceeding with payment. The registration fee is non-refundable, and all tickets are personal and non-transferable. Identity verification will be conducted with a valid ID, passport, or driver's license upon arrival at the Vespa Village Welcome Area. In cases involving a refund from the organizer, management fees will apply and be deducted from the refund amount.

-- Art. 7 Accommodation

Each participant is responsible for arranging their own accommodation.-- Art. 8 Expulsion

Participants who endanger the safety of others, damage vehicles or infrastructure, or harm the reputation of the event may be excluded without compensation and held liable for damages. Political or religious symbols or any other items potentially controversial among participants are prohibited.

In cases of loss or severe damage to credentials (personal or motorcycle), access rights may be forfeited. Participants submitting false registration information or violating event rules are automatically excluded, with no reimbursement provided.



All decisions by the organizers are final. The Vespa World Club reserves the right to enforce decisions for the event or future international events.

If, for any reason, attendance at part of the event is limited to a certain number of participants, registered participants will have priority to attend.

Each Vespa Club president is responsible to approve the participation of his true members in order to ensure the good atmosphere of the event and they must avoid the registration of fraudulent participants. The organization reserves the final right of admission.

-- Art. 9 Complaints

-- Art. 10 Liability

Only original and insured vehicles are allowed at the event.

Each participant drives and competes at his own risk.

The organizer is not liable for personal injury, property damage, or financial loss before, during, or after the event. By registering, participants accept the general rules, including these terms, and exempt the Vespa Club de España and Vespa World Club from liability.

Compliance with current Spanish law is required (e.g., helmet use, protective clothing, speed limits, no driving under the influence of alcohol, etc.).-- Art. 11 Acceptance of Regulations

By registering, participants accept the event's general rules and terms, including those in this document.

Participants also accept the following statement:

"I explicitly agree that all personal data provided may be used, stored, and analyzed for registration, organizational, and statistical purposes by the Vespa World Club and the organizer. This includes the collection, storage, and use of personal data for post-event verification."

Participants registered by an official Vespa Club are also subject to their club's rules. The organizer may use club data for registration, organization, and statistical analysis. Each National Vespa Club is authorized to access individual club data within its country for verification and control purposes.

Under no circumstances will data be shared with third parties outside the Vespa World Club beyond what is necessary for the event. The organizer will protect participants' personal data from unauthorized access and delete it post-event.

-- Art. 12 Surveillance Service

The organizer reserves the right to implement a CCTV system at the event venue and parking area.

-- Art. 13 Alcohol, drugs and weapons

The organizer reserves the right to deny access to or remove from the event any visitor who: A - Is suspected of carrying illegal weapons, illegal drugs, or items that may compromise event security

B - Exhibits behavior suggesting involvement in illegal substance trafficking

C - Is found in possession of illegal weapons or substances on the premises

D - Has previously caused public order issues at other events

E - Is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, whether legal or illegal.
